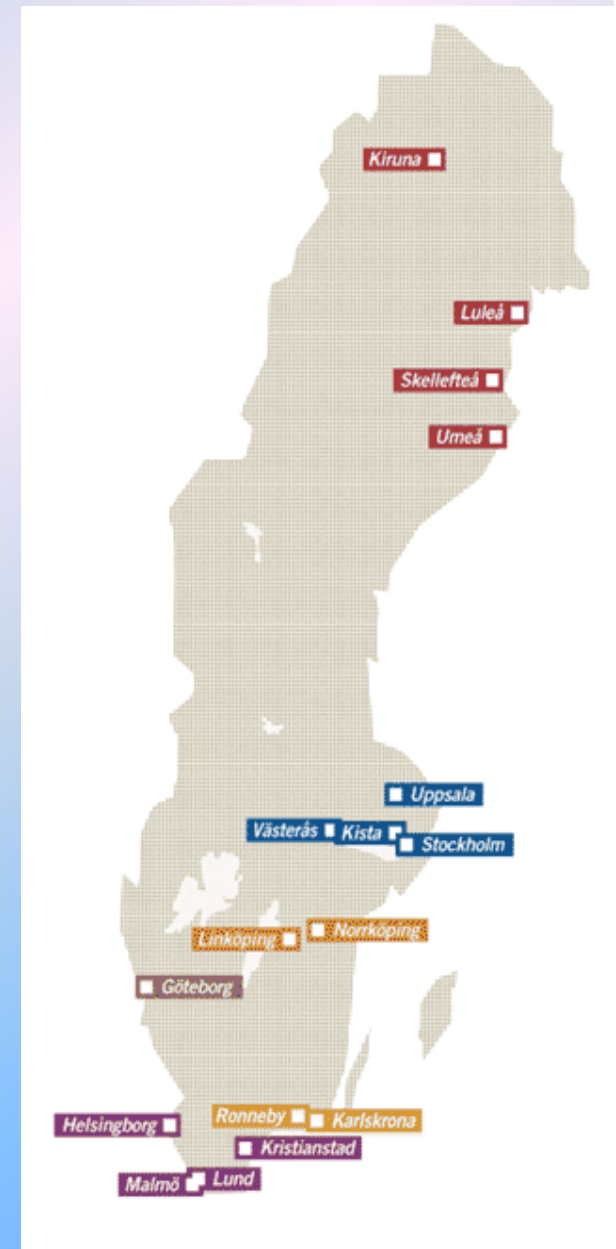
SIBED Highlights

- Implements Sweden- Israel MOU for Industrial R&D Cooperation (2000)
- Launched: May 2002
- Eextended and expanded
- Projects must have clear commercial potential
- Short term projects (12-18 months)
- R&D Grants from respective countries to selected projects
- “Joint” budget - 5 M Euro

Role of Testbed: Sweden - ICT Clusters

Clusters:

Geographically centered Networks of interconnected companies, suppliers, academic institutions, industrial research institutes, science parks and technology incubators, operating in an environment characterized by a high degree of specialization

Objects of funding

- German-Israeli joint industrial R&D projects in Biotechnology

Eligible

- German and Israeli companies
- German and Israeli universities and research institutions as subcontractors of the companies
- Focus on small and medium size enterprises, big companies are also eligible to submit R&D proposals
- German partners will be supported by BMBF
- Israeli partners will be supported by OCS
